1	Coordinator Communications Due to the current situation in Italy, the Coordinator did not yet receive all the original signed document to complete the Partnership Agreement (PA) procedure. 2	a. WP1 activities As project leader of WP1 S. Usmanov exposed his opinion for the next Workshop. In this regard, he is collecting possible keynote speakers for Uzbekistan, that would be more depending on UNESCO office in Tashkent. He explained the willingness to invite specialist from Samarqand, Bukhara and Khiva even though he reported that there are limited founds. S. Usmanov also proposes maximum 4 specialists for stakeholders (also due to refunds). In particular he proposes 2 specialists: [] and [] from TTU. Then, S. Usmanov exposed that next activity of WP1 will be the agenda preparation (deadline 15/06/2020) that will include objectives and schedules as well as final list of speakers. The Coordinator suggested to S. Usmanov to concentrate invited speakers on the topics, especially for the purpose of stimulating interest, comments, suggestions and questions. In this regard, it has been clarified that the workshop is open to anyone interested. Moreover, the Coordinator suggested a correct balance between stakeholders from Uzbekistan and Tajikistan as well as a clear separation between: associate partners (UNESCO and the Ministry of Culture of Uzbekistan); invited speakers from Uzbekistan and Tajikistan; other interested people.	



L. Abrahamczyk proposed a questionnaire in order to request information helping the developing of the project and, moreover, he proposed to split the workshop in two parts: a part dedicated to invited people and the other part focusing on CH assets situation by the experts point of view. The Coordinator agrees with this proposal.

L. Abrahamczyk proposed to postponed deadlines and then to modify the project program even if the Coordinator is not sure when the Agency could answer to this request. However, the Coordinator disagrees to postponed the workshop and suggests if projects leaders agree to cancel the workshop and replace it with a questionnaire (by using September deadline). Anyway, it is complicated to manage it now because there aren't official answer by the Agency.

L. Abrahamczyk disagree to cancel the workshop because the development of the master course should keep going on, and for this reason he proposes to postpone the workshop by the end of this year or first months of the next one. The Coordinator reminds that this decision involves also to rearrange the September meeting after the workshop so this proposal have to be considered.

If this proposal will be accepted, by September project leaders need to have answers through the questionnaire (draft) for stakeholders (in order to collect basic information that could help the beginning of WP3), that it must be built up in time by S. Usmanov helped by J. Niyazov and someone want to help.

The decision to postpone (if necessary) the workshop is accepted by all the participants.
