Staff costs and travels from July 2021 to the end of the project will be payed 30 days after the receipt of the 40% from EACEA if the project partners have spent 70% of what they received (more than 280.000,00 €). The rest of the money will be sent at the end of the project and after the approval of the achieved results (only eligible and documented expenses will be covered). At the end of each plenary and virtual meetings, a draft of the minutes with the relevant assumed decisions will be send to the PL.


After the collection of integrations and revisions, the final version will be sent for the approval.
