## 1. Organization of Strategic Forum

Within the framework of an Erasmus+ Capacity Building ERAMCA project, strategic workshop forum will be organized in TTPU, Uzbekistan on 15th September, 2020. The date of the forum might change according to suggestions of project partners and stakeholders. For this workshop will be invited all stakeholders, other public and private agencies which is mentioned in Deliverable D1.1 report.

Aim of this forum is to gather all stakeholders who is responsible for cultural heritage management to understand and collect information about real needs and competence for young specialists in Environmental Risk Assessment and Mitigation on Cultural Heritage assets. Total number of participants will be around 50-60 peoples, including key note speakers. Around nine key note speakers will be attended and maximum four of them will be from stakeholders of Tajikistan. The travel and stay costs of keynote speakers will covered by ERAMCA project.

In the forum, keynote speakers will demonstrate the real needs in Uzbekistan and Tajikistan in terms of competencies and problems to be solved by considering the environmental actions on cultural heritage assets. Keynote speakers requested to submit their position papers to project leaders by the 15th of August, 2020. The submitted position papers will be analysed by Project's partners to prepare a fruitful discussion. Results and findings of the strategy forum will be used to develop a strategic educational agenda for master program.

## 2. In case of quarantine period extended

In case of strategic forum will not be organized due to extension of COVID-19 pandemic period. Instead, the forum will be conducted by mean of virtual meeting. Keynote speakers from Uzbekistan and Tajikistan will be invited to join virtual meeting and present their position papers. The position papers will be distributed to other project partners by the email.

In order to collect additional supportive information to understand the real needs in each country the questionnaires have been developing by TTPU, SamSACII and IWPHE. The first version of questionnaires will be ready by the 15th of June and it will share to other project partners for their review. After revision, the final version of questionnaires will be distributed to stakeholders in Uzbekistan and Tajikistan to obtain responses.

All responses should be collected not later than 15th of August, 2020. Then these collected materials with position papers will be used to develop a strategic educational agenda for master program.
